Pursuant to Section 1.5(a) of the Disclosure Agreement, a material event has occurred with respect to the downgrade by S&P (Standard and Poor's) of the rating on the Bonds.

On January 5, 2017, S&P downgraded the Institute's long-term debt rating to BBB+ and short-term Rating to VMIG2. Accordingly, the rating on the Bonds has been downgraded to BBB+ A2/VMIG2 with a stable outlook.
