Executive Summary FY 2017: Fourth Quarter

Transaction

As of January 1, 2017 the University of Kansas Hospital Authority (Authority) became the sole corporate member of Hays Medical Center, Inc. (HaysMed). HaysMed owns and operates a 206-bed acute care hospital that provides healthcare services on its campus in Hays, Kansas, a city of about 21,000 residents four hours west of Kansas City. HaysMed is the sole member of The Hays Medical Center Foundation (HMCF).

Both HaysMed and HMCF became members of the Obligated Group on May 10, 2017, joining the Authority, Jayhawk Primary Care, Inc., Mid-America Cardiology Associates, Inc., Kansas University Physicians, Inc. and the University of Kansas Physicians as the members of the Obligated Group under the Master Trust Indenture.

Executive Summary FY 2017: Fourth Quarter

Statistics

- Patient Days increased 17.0% (8.0% pre HaysMed), Discharges increased 20.5% (7.5% pre HaysMed) from the prior year same quarter.
- The Case Mix Index (CMI) decreased from 1.8985 in the prior year same quarter to 1.8305. Pre HaysMed was a decrease of 2.0% to 1.8609.
- The Average Length of Stay (ALOS) decreased to 5.35 from 5.51 from the prior year same quarter. The pre HaysMed figure was 5.54 this quarter.

Net Patient Revenue

- Net Patient Revenue increased by 15.8%, or \$70.6 million, from the previous year's same quarter. Bad debt/charity was 2.3% percent of gross charges which was lower than the previous year's same quarter figure of 3.9%.
- The increase in Net Patient Revenue was primarily driven by the addition of HaysMed, which added \$42.4 million, as well as growth in the KC Division.
- Other Operating Revenue increased by \$7.5 million. HaysMed accounted for \$3.4 million of that. The remaining \$4.2 million was driven specialty by pharmacy growth.

Operating Expenses

• Total operating expenses increased by 25.4%, or \$111.8 million, from the previous year's same quarter. The addition of HaysMed accounts for \$47.2 million and the remaining \$64.6 million was growth in the KC Division.

Operating Results

• The Authority's fourth quarter GASB operating margin was \$9.7 million, or 1.7% (0.8% FASB), which was \$33.7 million less than the prior year's same quarter GASB operating margin of \$43.4 million, or 9.0% (8.3% FASB).

Non-Operating Results

- Fourth quarter investment gains were \$12.8 million (\$3.8 million related to HaysMed), compared to gains of \$8.8 million in the prior year same quarter.
- The Authority reported a combined Net Income for the fourth quarter of \$21.5 million, which was \$27.0 million lower than the prior year same quarter net income of \$48.5 million.



Executive Summary FY 2017: June 2017 YTD

Balance Sheet

- Unrestricted cash increased \$215.5 million during the twelve months. The change in cash included the following major components:
 - Cash flow from operations of \$144.9 million.
 - Acquisition of assets of \$(196.0) million.
 - Debt issuance increased project funds by \$150.0 million
 - Debt service of \$(29.1) million.
 - Special item: Hays \$131.1 million
- FY 2017 fourth quarter EBIDA was \$46.1 million.
- Equities were approximately 17.6% of the total portfolio at June 30, 2017 (12.8% pre HaysMed). The Authority had no swaps at June 30, 2017.
