Does your school have school security officers?

Does your school have distance learning capability? If so, how do teachers track student progress?

Yes. We use a dedicated software platform to provide resources and a system for feedback on assignments. Teachers meet with students weekly on a dedicated schedule both asynchronously and in real time through video.

What percentage of students have internet access at home? Is your school or district taking any actions to ensure students will have access to internet at home?

I Less than 10% of our students do not have home internet access. We provide hotspots for students who do not.
